“ Hi. My name is Kelly and I am a Senior Environmental Advisor at TC Energy. I work with the Environmental Team on the Project, and part of our role is to look at potential project effects to soil and land capability, water, fish and wildlife, archaeological resources, air quality and noise, as well as those potential affects to communities and their economies.

An Environmental Protection Plan is developed for the Project to identify mitigations to be implemented during construction to minimize our environmental effects. We work with regulatory bodies, communities, landowners and Indigenous groups to seek input and refine mitigations in our plans.

A key part of our process is adaptive management, where we continuously evaluate, monitor and implement corrective measures as needed during construction. Our team has been conducting environmental studies on the Project for over three years, and we are committed to managing our project footprint while delivering the energy you need.
