“ Hello, my name is Mel and I am a Senior Manager of Indigenous Relations, Canada at TC Energy. I provide leadership for the implementation of the Indigenous Relations policy and program on the Project.

We understand that project development has the potential to impact Indigenous groups and we have an obligation to engage to minimize those potential impacts. Our engagement with communities includes sharing of project information, providing funding to assess impacts, and meeting regularly to resolve issues and concerns. This allows us to build relationships on our projects in a proactive and meaningful way.

The Indigenous Engagement Program for the Project was developed and adapted according to the nature, location and potential effects of the Project and considered the identified interests, information needs, and concerns of Indigenous groups.

Our goal is to provide fulsome Project information, allowing Indigenous groups to make informed decisions and equip them with the tools necessary to identify conditions that have the potential to affect their rights. We began early engagement on sections of the Project in August of 2017 and our team will continue to manage issues and concerns brought forward throughout the lifecycle of the Project.
